Rural and Remote Scholarship to attend the
SA Education Day, 8 November 2024

This funding is available to support Foundation members who work in regional South Australia

1. Eligibility requirements

- 1.1. Applicants must be a health professional (ie. registered nurse, (RN), physiotherapist, occupational therapist)
- 1.2. Applicants must be currently registered with their relevant professional registration board and supply proof with their application.
- 1.3. Applicants must be able to demonstrate an ongoing commitment to continence management and care although they are not required to be currently working solely in this area (up to 50% of their role if not working in a continence role).
- 1.4. Applicants are to be a Professional Member of the Continence Foundation of Australia
- 1.5. Applicants must work in a rural or remote setting as defined by the Australian Standard Geographical Classification as RA2-RA5.

2. Application and offer process

- Applicants are required to complete the Scholarship Application below, including the three written questions and supporting documentation.
- Submit applications to membership@continence.org.au
- Applications are to be received no later than Monday 23rd September.
- Applicants will be notified of the outcome by phone and/or email by Friday 30th September.

3. Conditions of scholarship

3.1. Value of scholarships

- Scholarships to the value of \$800 and will be awarded to up to 3 successful applicants to cover the costs of registration, accommodation and travel.
- Receipts must be presented for costs to be reimbursed.
- Meals and airport transfers are not included in the scholarship and must be covered by the recipient.
- Accommodation is for a maximum of 2 consecutive nights and be utilised within 24 hours either side of the Education Day.
- Your registration fee will be reimbursed if you are successful in receiving a scholarship.

3.2. Conditions

The successful applicants will be required to:

- Attend the Education Day at the Glenelg Pier Hotel in Glenelg on 8th of November 2024.
- Submit a 300 word report/article by Monday 25th November, with details of the session/s that you found most beneficial to your ongoing continence practice.
