# Rural and Remote sponsorship to attend the

### Western Australia Education Day, 25 October 2024

This scholarship is available to support the Foundation's Professional members who work in rural or regional Western Australia

### 1. Eligibility requirements

- 1.1. Applicants must be a health professional (eg. registered nurse, (RN), physiotherapist, occupational therapist)
- 1.2. Applicants must be currently registered with their relevant professional registration board and supply proof with their application.
- 1.3. Applicants must be able to demonstrate an ongoing commitment to continence management and care although they are not required to be currently working solely in this area (up to 50% of their role in a non-continence role).
- 1.4. Applicant must be a Professional Member of the Continence Foundation of Australia
- 1.5. Applicants must work in a rural or remote setting as defined by the Australian Standard Geographical Classification – Remoteness Areas (ASGC-RA). Applications will be accepted from applicants working in the categories listed below:
  - RA3 Outer Regional Australia
  - RA4 Remote Australia
  - RA5 Very Remote Australia

#### 2. Application and offer process

- Applicants are required to complete the online Scholarship Application Form, including the three written questions and supporting documentation.

- Applications are to be received no later than Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September.
- Applicants will be notified of the outcome by phone and/or email by Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September.

# 3. Conditions of scholarship

# 3.1. Value of scholarships

- Scholarships to the value of \$2,500 will be awarded to up to two successful applicants to cover the costs of registration, accommodation and travel.
- Receipts must be presented for costs to be reimbursed.
- Meals and airport transfers are not included in the scholarship and must be covered by the recipient.
- Accommodation is for a maximum of two consecutive nights and be utilised within 24 hours either side of the Education Day.
- Your registration fee will be reimbursed if you are successful in receiving a scholarship.

### 3.2. Additional Conditions

The successful applicants will be required to:

- Attend the Education Day at the Rendezvous Hotel Perth, Scarborough on 25 October 2024.
- Submit a 300-600 word report/article by Monday 27<sup>th</sup> November, with details of the session/s that you found most beneficial to your ongoing continence practice.
- Report/Article may be published in the Foundation's In The News
- If successful, scholarship recipients will not be able to reapply for another scholarship for a three year period.
